Role Overview

While not responsible for day-to-day operations, this Trustee will support the Board by overseeing long-term engineering strategy, compliance, sustainability, and the preservation of heritage steam assets.

Key Responsibilities

- Support the development of a long-term Steam Engineering Strategy balancing operational needs, heritage authenticity, financial sustainability, and volunteer capacity.
- Ensure compliance with railway safety regulations, engineering standards, and statutory requirements relating to steam operations.
- Promote a culture of safety, competence, and continuous improvement in steam engineering practices.
- Champion historical authenticity and heritage value in locomotive restoration and presentation.
- Liaise with engineering managers, boiler inspectors, workshops, and volunteer teams to understand priorities and challenges.
- Support succession planning, skills development, and training for staff and volunteers in steam engineering.
- Provide Board-level assurance on risk management relating to steam engineering operations.
